# FOGO - collected fortnightly (alternating) FOOD ORGANICS GARDEN ORGANICS

## Green bin tips

- ✓ Place these items loose in the bin and do not compact as the bin may not empty.
- ✓ Lawn clippings are less likely to stick to the bottom of your bin, if you line it with leaves.
- ✗ Strictly no plastics or other household rubbish in this bin as it will reduce the ability of this material to be used for compost.
- ✗ Do not place rubbish, rocks, stumps, plastic shopping bags, plastics, bricks, building material, nappies, car parts, glass or scrap metal in your green bin.

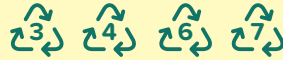
# Recycling - collected fortnightly (alternating)

## Yellow bin tips Remember! No plastic bags or soft plastics of any kind in the recycling bin.

- ✓ Please empty contents and rinse out.
- ✓ Always use your own re-useable coffee cup, not take away cups.
- ✓ Put plastics with recycle triangle numbered 1, 2 or 5 in this bin.



- ✗ Polystyrene belongs in the Red lidded Landfill bin
- ✗ Do not place plastic with the recycle triangle numbered 3, 4, 6, or 7.



- ✗ Do not place light globes or waxed cardboard in your yellow bin.

### PLEASE NO BAGS OR BAGGED ITEMS IN THIS BIN



Plastic bottles with the lids removed



(Lids go in red bin)

✓ YES PLEASE



Plastic Milk bottles



Newspapers, magazines and books



Paper and flattened cardboard boxes



Steel cans, aluminium cans, foil trays



Rigid plastics, biscuit trays, margarine tubs and ice-cream tubs

Soiled food wrap and all forms of polystyrene



Long-life/Tetra Pak cartons and coffee cups



Glass



e-waste – electronics, phones or DVDs (take to a waste facility)

# Glass - collected every four weeks

## Purple bin tips

- ✓ Please empty contents and rinse out.
- ✗ No bottles with cigarette butts.
- ✗ Broken glass must not be wrapped.
- ✗ Do not place hazardous waste, light bulbs, laboratory equipment, televisions, computers, cathode ray tubes, porcelain products, cook tops, automobile and vehicle glass including windscreens, and fluorescent tubes in your purple bin.

Window glass and mirrors (glass only  
no frames)

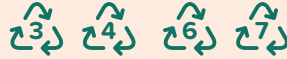

# Landfill - collected weekly

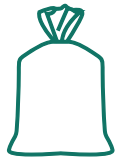
## Red bin tips

- ✓ **ALL plastic bags and soft plastics.**
- ✓ Place all rubbish in this bin in a bag or container to reduce the chance of waste blowing out during collection.
- ✓ Take other items and larger items to a waste facility.

- ✓ Place plastic with the recycle triangle numbered 3, 4, 6 or 7 in this bin.



**✓ YES PLEASE**



Household rubbish



Plastic bags and other plastics (including cling film and soft plastic packaging) that are not marked recyclable 1, 2 or 5



Cigarette butts



Wrapped nappies  
sanitary items and wipes

**✗ NO THANKS**



Plastics that contain the 1, 2 or 5 recycling symbol



Food or garden waste



Hazardous or chemical waste



Glassware, light bulbs or mirrors



Large amounts of timber, no bricks or rubble

# FOGO caddy



**✓ YES PLEASE**



Coffee grounds, tea bags



Meat, prawn shells, fish scales



Food scraps, dairy products



Tissues, paper towels



Egg shells, hair, feathers

**✗ NO THANKS**



Plastic supermarket or non-compostable bags

## FOGO caddy tips

- ✓ Only use green compostable bag liners in your FOGO caddy (these are supplied by Council).
- ✓ Green compostable bag liners are derived from corn and will break down in a composting environment.
- ✓ Kitchen caddy contents must be emptied into your green FOGO bin.
